Walk Time	5hrs~
Description	We walk up the valley of the Ae on the eastern side, cross the river and return on the western side. The car park is at about 125m, and highest point reached about 200m, so only modest climbing. Walking is on forest roads most of the way, with a final 1.5km on (a quiet) public road. On the route we pass a display of old forestry equipment.
Travel	Murray St. Car park at 9:30 am. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. Travel to Dumfries (A75). Take the Edinburgh route (A701) off the Dumfries by-pass and travel past Locharbriggs and Amisfield. Take left to Ae about 4km after Amisfield. Turn (right) down to the car park just past the village of Ae.
Start Time	10.30am.
Parking	Free all day
Walkers Dogs	. At owner's discretion. Dogs on leads please.
Please Note	Ae forest is much used by mountain bikers at weekends - be aware. (part of the 7 Stanes network)
Refreshments	Bring snacks and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots, sticks and usual gear.
