WALK 264

SATURDAY 24 JANUARY 2015

MABIE FOREST

Distance	10 kms. / 6 miles
Walk Time	4+ hours.
Walk Description	A strenuous walk in parts , following the Lochaber Trail over Craigbill Hill (views to the Waterloo Monument, Criffel and the Solway), then passing above Lochaber Loch before following the link path to join the Nith View Trail to return to the start. The walk route and distance may be altered on the day to reflect weather and ground conditions.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Mini bus available. From Annan 20 miles, 35 minutes, journey via Dumfries then the A710 New Abbey road. Entrance to Mabie Forest just after that to Mabie Farm Park.
Walk Starting Point	10.15 a.m. at the first car parking area after the Pay point. Car-park charge £3 all vehicles. Toilets near to walk start.
Walkers Dogs	Guide dogs only.
Refreshments	Bring lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots and poles. Warm gear, waterproofs and other winter clothing.
