Distance	Approx. 5.25 miles
Walk Time	Approx. 3.5 hours
Walk Description	A circular walk around Sanquhar, on minor roads, tracks and paths. There is some uphill walking and steep steps. It can be muddy when wet.
Travel	Make own way to start point which is the curling pond car park on McKendrick Road. Approx. 1 hour from Annan but allow a little longer because of road works. Travel to Dumfries on A75 to Cuckoo Bridge roundabout. Then take the right turn onto the Glasgow Road (A76). Continue on this road until you get to Sanquhar. Continue along Sanquhar High Street, through the narrow section at the tollbooth, then take first left into McKendrick Road. The curling pond car park is immediately on the right. On street parking is also available.
Walk Start Point / Toilets	Start Point – 10:30am at Curling Pond Car Park. Postcode (nearest) :- DG4 6BN What3Words:- starting.trails.simulator Grid Ref :- NS 779 099 Toilets – public toilets available nearby.
Dogs	NO dogs please.
Refreshments	Bring own snacks, lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Usual outdoor wear for the time of year. Some of the paths are overgrown so long trousers are recommended.
