Distance	Approx. 5.25 miles
Walk Time	Approx. 3.5 hours.
Walk Description	A circular walk around the north of Moffat on gravel and tarmac paths, forest and farm tracks and across farm fields. Muddy in places. The walk follows the River Annan a short way then a steady incline up through the Community Woodland beech trees onto Gallow Hill. Round Gallow Hill and down to Archbank and on to Sparrow Hill before dropping down to Frenchland and Rogermoor.
Travel	From Annan approx. 30 miles up the A74(M) to J15 then A701 into Moffat. Station Park Car Park is on the left as you enter Moffat from the south. Mini-bus available for 16 passengers. Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m.
Walk Start Point / Toilets	Start Point – 10.30 a.m. Station Park Car Park, Moffat Grid Ref :- NT 083 048 What 3 Words :- debater.savings.headsets Nearest Post Code :- DG10 9ER Toilets – public toilets diagonally across the road from the car park.

Refreshments	Bring snacks, lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Usual outdoor gear for time of year, boots and poles recommended.
