

ANNAN WALKING GROUP – WALK 429

SUNDAY 11th SEPTEMBER 2022 BRIGHOUSE BAY

Walk Leader(s)	Roderick McCallum (01461 202 104) Lewis Kinnear (01461 207 789)
Distance	Approx. 5.25 miles
Walk Time	Approx. 3.5 - 4 hours.
Walk Description	A Core Path walk from the car-park at the head of Brighthouse Bay skirting Cairniehill to Chapelton Cottages then heading for the Solway at Ringdoo Bay (look out for turitella communis) before following the coast back to our start point. Walk on farm tracks, paths, grassland, and minor road (short distance). Uneven in places, no stiles, uphill at start and a bit up and down along coast as we climb from sea level to cliff tops (200ft) and down again. Great sea views and of Isle of Man if fine day.
Travel	From Annan 51 miles (1¼ hour) journey via A75 and A711 to Kirkcudbright. Take a right there onto the sign-posted Borgue road, A755 then B727, for some 4½ miles before turning left at sign for Brighthouse Bay Holiday Park. Then approx. 1½ miles on minor road with passing places to the Car-Park. Mini-bus available for 16 passengers. Murray Street car park at 9.15 a.m. NOTE EARLY START
Walk Start Point / Toilets	Start Point – 10.30 a.m. Car park at head of the Bay. Grid Ref :- NX 634 458 What 3 Words :- clotting.years.chest Nearest Post Code :- DG6 4TS Toilets – Toilets at Car-Park.
Dogs	Dogs on lead okay.
Refreshments	Bring snacks, lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Usual outdoor gear for time of year. Sticks might come in handy for the terrain.
