

ANNAN WALKING GROUP – WALK 460

SATURDAY 23rd DECEMBER 2023 NEWTON WAMPHRAY

Walk Leader(s)	Craig & Heather Duggan (07756654315)
Distance	Approx. 5 miles.
Walk Time	Approx. 3.5 hours.
Walk Description	Travel to Service Station at Johnstonebridge for toilet facilities. From there we drive to the village hall at Newton. The walk then proceeds along quiet backroads, good underfoot, to take us to Wamphray Kirk. We then return to Newton via some off road footpaths and quiet country lanes. All mostly good underfoot. Some uphill sections, nothing too strenuous. The walk provides excellent views of upper Annandale.
Travel	Head east out of Annan B722 and after approx. 4.3/4 miles turn left at roundabout and join A74M (Junction 20). Turn off at J16 for Johnstonebridge services. Pass back over A74(M) and turn right on B7076, after approx. 1.5 miles turn right to Newton Wamphray. Proceed over river and turn right at cross roads. Village hall is approx. 200 yards on left. Mini-bus available. Return Fare £5 Seats are on first come, first served basis. Please bring change of shoes to keep the bus clean. Annan at 9.30 a.m. to provide lifts for other members.
Walk Start Point / Toilets	Start Point – Village hall in Newton. (Approx 20 miles north of Annan) Grid Ref :- NY 112947 What3Words:- Start Time – 10:30 a.m. Toilets – Service Station at Johnstonebridge
Dogs	Dogs welcome. Short leads please
Refreshments	Bring snacks, lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Appropriate outdoor gear for the time of year and ground conditions.
