Distance	Approx. 5.5 miles
Walk Time	Approx. 3 hours.
Walk Description	A circular walk on good forest roads with some short easy inclines
Travel	From Annan take the B723 to Lockerbie. Go over first roundabout and stay on old road, turn right up to junction for Sibbaldbie and Boreland. Go through Boreland village and after approximately 2.5 miles turn left at the sign for Sandyford onto forest road. Carry along forest road and after approx 1 mile, at fork follow road round left up to dam, and after approx half a mile car parking on left at the dam If going by car you can continue through main street of Lockerbie, turning right at the old Academy, continue on the B723 to Boreland village, then as above. Bus won't get over small bridge. Unfortunately there are no drivers for the minibuses so will anyone driving please pick people up at the car park. Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m.
