

ANNAN WALKING GROUP – WALK 516

Saturday 25th April Kirkton, Kirkmahaoe

Distance	Approximately 5 1/2 to 6 miles
Walk Time	Approximately 4 1/2 hours
Walk Description	Low level easy walk. Leave from centre of Kirkton Village, for a circular walk taking in a nature ramble along the grassy banks of the River Nith and back to Kirton across field and tracks. Mostly wide, rough grass paths which can be muddy after rain. Short stretches can be fairly narrow and sloping with an odd high step and gates.
Travel	Directions: Head west out of Annan turning left onto the A75 towards Dumfries. Follow the A75 heading towards Dumfries for approximately 16 miles until you come to the roundabout at the Shell garage, Take the second exit and continue on the A75 Dumfries bypass. At the next roundabout take the second exit straight ahead. At the following roundabout Take the third exit towards Heathhall passed Dalscone farm on your left and continue to the next roundabout staying left and taking the first exit pass the Esso garage on your right and continue on this for approximately 800 m and take the left turning towards Kirkton. Carry on along this road and when you come to Kirkton, continue to the middle of the village and parking is available in the centre of the village triangle. Mini-bus available. Return Fare £5 Seats are on first come, first served basis. Please bring change of shoes to keep the bus clean. Mini-bus departs Murray Street car park, Annan at 9.30am.
Walk Start Point / Toilets	Start Point – Centre of Kirkton just opposite the village hall. Grid Ref :- NX975815 What3Words:- nips.regret capillary Nearest Post Code :- DG1 1ST Start Time – 10.15am Toilets – No
Dogs	Dogs on leads and in own car.
Refreshments	Bring snacks, lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Appropriate outdoor gear for the time of year and ground conditions.
